

SCREEN MIRRORING WITHOUT AN INTERNET TV BOX: ANDROID DEVICES

If you don't have a Chromecast or Amazon Fire TV Stick, you may still be able to mirror your device's screen. Whether you can will depend on which TV, smartphone or tablet device you own. Newer TVs have screen mirroring software built in.

How to stream:

Step 1: You will usually need to head into your network menu to enable screen mirroring.

Step 2: Select Display & Sounds, followed by Enable Display Mirroring / Wireless Display.

Step 3: Your phone or tablet device will also need screen mirroring capabilities. Different manufacturers have different names for it. Typically, you'll find screen mirroring in the quick access menu or in the network settings in your device.

- Huawei's screen mirroring is called MirrorShare
- Samsung's screen mirroring is called Screen Mirroring or Smart View
- HTC's screen mirroring is called HTC Connect
- Sony's screen mirroring is simply called Screen Mirroring
- LG's screen mirroring is called Miracast

Step 4: Once you have enabled the screen mirroring on your device, connect your device to the TV and your device's screen will now be mirrored to the TV.
